## Original Intent

## **Nepios**

Infant, baby not old enough to speak or function.

This infant of God's house will make sounds of selfish whining concerning his own provision and protection. The child is in the house and an heir, but not mature enough to have a right to the inheritance. This child is easily influenced by various circumstances, teachings, and schemes of men. He is given to jealousy, quarreling, divisions, and boasting. He is in desperate need of tutors and guardians to agree with the Spirit and unveil his/her maturity.

## **Paidion**

A little child mature enough to understand and proclaim.

During this season the child grows in strength, wisdom, and grace.
